## COURSE DESCRIPTION AND POLICIES

Spanish 1 is an introductory Spanish course where students study pronunciation, vocabulary, sentence structure, grammar, and cultural readings that develop the four language skills: listening, reading, speaking and writing. The final goal of the course is to provide the foundations for oral comprehension and proficiency in using the Spanish language in real communicative situations at the introductory level. The audio CD's are very important for the distance learning classes. The tests will be similar to the workbook. I recommend you do the activities in the textbook. 2) Then, do the workbook and laboratory manual (they are both in the workbook). The workbook and the lab manual for Lessons 1-5 will be DUE on **July 24, 2009**). 3) Study for the test by reviewing the lesson in the textbook. If you want, take the "Practice Quiz" on-line before each quiz or exam. You have to memorize the vocabulary in each lesson and learn the grammar concepts. A good study guide is the Practice Test at the end of the lessons. The **Audio CD's for the lab manual** may be purchased from the bookstore (661-763-7731).
