**REGISTRATION SCHEDULE-SUMMER and FALL 2012**

Applications for Summer and Fall 2012 are available beginning **February 21, 2012.**

**Priority Registration is as follows:**

1. EOPS, VA, CONTINUING and NEW SSS, FOSTER YOUTH and FORMER FOSTER YOUTH (emancipated foster youth up to and including the age of 24)  
**Scheduling begins Monday, April 9, 2012**
2. PHI THETA KAPPA STUDENTS, CONTINUING ASB OFFICERS & ATHLETES, TRIO GRANT STUDENTS, and TAFT COLLEGE STAFF  
**Scheduling begins Monday, April 16, 2012**
3. CONTINUING MATRICULATING STUDENTS  
**Scheduling begins Monday, April 23, 2012**
4. LOCAL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS & COMMUNITY MEMBERS IN WEST KERN CC DISTRICT (West Kern CC District includes all community members of the Taft College service area, defined as those residing in zip codes: 93268, 93224, 93258, 93276, and 93252)  
**Scheduling begins Monday, April 30, 2012**
5. RETURNING (FORMER) and NEW MATRICULATING STUDENTS (without Bachelor or Advanced Degree). Must take placement test and complete orientation prior to scheduling classes.  
**Scheduling begins Monday, May 7, 2012**
6. STUDENTS EXEMPT FROM MATRICULATION/OPEN REGISTRATION  
**Scheduling begins Monday, May 14, 2012**

**Students who may be exempt from the matriculation process are:**

- A. Students who have completed 60 or more units or who have graduated from an accredited U.S. college or university with an associate degree or higher.
- B. Students who plan to enroll in five units or fewer and who have declared one of the following goals:
  - Advance in current career/job
  - Maintain certificates/license
  - Personal/educational development
  - Complete credits for high school diploma
- C. Students who are enrolled full time at another institution (high school or college) and will be taking five units or fewer (excluding English and math courses).
- D. Students who have previously been assessed (within the last two years) and have written verification of scores from an assessment instrument off the Chancellor's approved list of instruments. (Exempt from placement testing only).
- E. Students transferring from another regionally accredited postsecondary institution with credit for degree-level English and/or mathematics. (Exempt from placement testing only).

The college will make reasonable efforts to ensure that all exempt students are provided the opportunity to participate in the various components of matriculation. Exempt students are not required to participate in the matriculation process but are encouraged to see a counselor at any time.
