Trustee Orrin reported on the CCLC Legislative conference and the discussions that centered on the impact of community colleges within the communities they serve. She commended staff for participation and attendance at the forums for the Vice President of Instruction.

#### **Academic Senate**

Geoffrey Dyer, AS President, introduced Dr. Sharyn Eveland as the incoming AS President. Mr. Dyer reported action of the AS including endorsing the California Academic Partnership Program Guided Pathways Alignment Program grant application as well as the ranking of new faculty position requests.

#### **Faculty Association**

Ruby Payne stated that a recent technology issue gave her and several department members an opportunity to appreciate the technology that is utilized on our campus and thanked faculty and staff for their work at getting the department's needs corrected.

#### **Distance Education**

Adam Bledsoe, Director of Distance Education, reported that 35% students are taking at least one DE course. He noted that the work being done for the Online Education Initiative consortium is paving the way for the department to meet the current and future needs of the DE student population.

#### **Business Services**

Amanda Bauer, Director of Fiscal Services, told the Board the department is finished with the tax documentation process for annual statements and is now in the process of budget preparation for the next fiscal year.

#### **Transition to Independent Living**

Aaron Markovits, Executive Director of TIL, introduced Aaron Jackson as a TIL student intern. Mr. Jackson reported that TIL students are completing community service projects, which has provided opportunity for the students to learn many tasks by hands-on application.

#### **Campus Safety & Security**

Kevin Altenhofel, Director of Campus Safety & Security, reported that he has been communicating with many campus stakeholders in an effort to make the campus smoke-free.

#### **Foundation**

Sheri Horn-Bunk, Executive Director of Foundation and Institutional Advancement, said that the West Kern Petroleum Forum is almost sold out. The event will feature former and new participants as well as a legislative representative panel.

#### **Student Services**

Severo Balason, Jr., Vice President of Student Services, reminded the Board of the upcoming annual fundraiser golf tournament.

#### CSEA, Chapter #543

Greg Hawkins, President of Chapter #543, thanked the Board for support of the two agreements on tonight's agenda. He told the Board that 135 employees will benefit from these items, 110 of which that live in the District.

#### **Information Services**

Andrew Prestage, Executive Director of Information Services, told the Board that a recent project was not going well but with the patience and assistance from faculty and staff, IT was able to fix the issue. He thanked the many staff members who supported the effort. The department is also in the process of reviewing safety technology lists and procedures.

#### **Child Development Center**

Meghan Hall-Silveira, Director of the Child Development Center, reported that today Building 4 at the CDC was open for use. She also thanked Distance Education staff for making videos to help students, parents, and staff navigate the CDC while under construction.

#### **Administrative Services**

Brock McMurray, Executive Vice President of Administrative Services, provided a report of campus facility projects including lighting, CDC improvements, athletic facility upgrades and the conversion of S-4 to a much needed chemistry laboratory.

Dr. Daniels reported that a Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges liaison held the first training to begin the accreditation cycle. New standards are in place for this cycle and key staff are working to familiarize themselves with the standards to prepare the campus community for their tasks in the accreditation process.

#### Events and Accolades

Dr. Daniels recapped the CCLC Legislative Summit, meetings with legislative representative Assemblyman Vince Fong and staff members of Senator Shannon Grove, the State of the County, and the Chamber of Commerce Installation event. With the support of the Board, the District was well represented at important events at local and state level. She commended Trustee White for his earned honor as Sportsman of the Year and Adam Bledsoe, Director of Distance Education, as Rotarian of the Year in the Taft chapter. Dr. Daniels also thanked the faculty/staff/students in the Engineering program for assisting a local group in an effort to build a monument in the Taft business district.

### **Scope of Work**

#### **Economic Impact Analysis**

*Operations spending impact*: Measures the direct, indirect, and induced (i.e., multiplier) employment and income effect of Client's payroll toward faculty, staff, work study students, and operations spending toward contractors and vendors on durable and non-durable goods.

**Student spending impact:** Measures the impact of new sales generated by out-of-region students and retained students who spend money on food, transportation, and other personal expenses while attending Client.

**Alumni impact**: Measures the impact of higher student earnings and the increased productivity of local businesses from human capital accumulation in the regional workforce.

#### **Investment Analysis**

**Student perspective** – Analyzes whether students are better off attending Client than not. #### Title of Board Item:

Siteimprove Software Subscription

#### Background:

Siteimprove software is a fully automated web accessibility tool that performs website checks, evaluates performance metrics, and uses industry benchmarks to allow users to assess the accessibility of web pages. Siteimprove flags errors and inconsistencies across all web pages and provides practical recommendations so the webmaster and others can prioritize and fix the most critical issues right away. Over the past five years, there have been several instances where outside companies have selected California Community Colleges to make sure that the website is compliant. I have attached an article regarding nationwide instances where this has happened; this software will minimize the risk to the institution.

#### Terms (if applicable):

Attached is a quote from Siteimprove outlining a service agreement, including the specific services available, fees, and invoice/payments.

#### Expense (if applicable):

The annual subscription fee (excluding applicable taxes) for the Included Services is: \$8,340.

#### Fiscal Impact Including Source of Funds (if applicable):

The fiscal impact is \$8,340 a year as long as you maintain the subscription. The Accessibility (508) Oversight Committee would argue the cost is minimal given the potential liability of not maintaining the accessibility of our website per federal and state mandates. Inaccessible webpages could lead to financial obligations for the college due to unforeseen litigation or fines resulting from not being in compliance.

## Fifty colleges sued in barrage of ADA lawsuits over web accessibility

Jason Camacho, a blind resident of Brooklyn, N.Y., is suing 50 colleges over the accessibility of their websites.

The 50 lawsuits, filed in November, say the colleges are in violation of the Americans With Disabilities Act, as their websites are not accessible to people with disabilities. Camacho uses a screen reader and said he experienced barriers when trying to access the colleges' websites.

Despite the court cases being filed in New York's Southern District, the institutions targeted are located all over the country. Almost all are private colleges, universities or conservatories, and include large research universities such as Northeastern University and Drexel University. Both institutions said they do not comment on ongoing legal matters. Also being sued are Cornell University, Vanderbilt University, the California Institute of the Arts, Oberlin College, Loyola University New Orleans, the Savannah College of Art and Design, and many others [1].

The lawsuits, which all appear to have similar wording, argue that because the colleges recruit students in New York, the colleges can be sued in New York. All the colleges recently took part in a college fair in New York City for prospective students interested in performing and visual arts, which Camacho says he attended.

Camacho's attorney, Jeffrey Gottlieb of Gottlieb and Associates, declined to comment, but has previously indicated that the intention of the lawsuits is to ensure accessibility for all. "If the website is not accessible, you're shut out," he told the <u>Times Union</u> [2] of Albany, N.Y.

Gottlieb and Associates describes itself as a "boutique litigation firm dedicated to representing disabled persons who's [sic] rights have been violated under the Americans with Disabilities Act." The firm says on its website that it works "solely on a contingent fee basis" which means that clients do not pay if their case is unsuccessful.

This is not the first time Camacho and Gottlieb have worked together to sue higher education institutions over website accessibility. New York University, Adelphi University, Monroe College, Lim College and the New York Code and Design Academy were all sued by Camacho earlier this year. The cases were settled out of court. A New York University spokesperson said the terms of its settlement with Camacho were confidential.

Camacho was also the lead plaintiff in several other ADA lawsuits filed in 2017, including against companies such as Peet's Coffee and Aldi.

While there are disability advocates who have single-handedly filed thousands of <u>ADA complaints</u> [3] against colleges and universities to U.S. Department of Education's Office for Civil Rights, there are few individuals who have taken so many colleges to court, said Chris Danielsen, director of public relations at the National Federation of the Blind. That group has sued many colleges and reached settlements with others over issues similar to those raised in the new round of lawsuits.

The litigation-first approach is not one the NFB advocates.

"We tend to worry a little bit when we see one individual filing a bunch of lawsuits at once like this, because it's not usually the best way to get a good result and enter into a good dialogue with the institutions," he said. "Our approach is usually to go to litigation only after all other approaches have failed."

Filing a lawsuit as a first move "puts universities on the defensive and is automatically adversarial," said Danielsen. But he added "it's not necessarily a bad thing that someone who isn't attending a university yet is doing some advocacy."

The NFB has created a self-advocacy toolkit for students who experience accessibility barriers at college but said it can be tough for them to deal with these issues on top of their schoolwork.

The trend of somebody finding an accessibility issue on a website, "however big or small," and filing a lawsuit is not unique to college and universities, said Danielsen. "There are plaintiffs and lawyers who just take a category of business, like wineries for example, and just sue a bunch of them all at once."

Filing large numbers of similarly worded ADA lawsuits against one type of business is sometimes referred to as "drive-by" litigation. This activity is widely seen as a means to get a quick settlement, rather than improve accessibility.

Whether Camacho is a disability rights advocate or an opportunist is irrelevant, said Peter Blanck, University Professor of law at Syracuse University and chairman of the <u>Burton Blatt Institute</u> [4], which aims to advance the participation of people with disabilities in society.

"It's beside the point whether there are 50 or 1,000 lawsuits," said Blanck. "These cases are reflective of a larger systemic problem -- that there is a lack of a strong commitment by many institutions to try to be as inclusive as possible."

It's been almost 30 years since the ADA was passed, and we should have made more progress, said Blanck. "Way back in the '90s I was asked to testify whether or not websites would be subject to the ADA," he said. "There is no question that universities have been on notice for a long time."

#### 1. DEFINITIONS

- a. Interpretation. Capitalized terms used in these Terms and Conditions will have the meanings ascribed to them in the Agreement or as defined below. Terms other than those defined below will be given their plain English meaning and terms of art having specialized meanings in the software industry will be construed in accordance with industry standards. Unless the context otherwise requires, words importing the singular include the plural and words importing the masculine include the feminine and vice versa where the context so requires.
- b. "Affiliate" means any entity directly or indirectly controlling or controlled by or in common control with a party, where "control" is defined in this context as the ownership of at least fifty percent (50%) or more of the voting stock or other interest entitled to vote on general decisions reserved to stockholders, partners, or other owners of such entity. An entity shall no longer be an Affiliate when through loss, divestment, dilution or other reduction of ownership, the requisite control no longer exists.
- "Confidential Information" means information that is marked or otherwise identified as confidential or proprietary, or that would otherwise appear to a reasonable person to be confidential or proprietary in the context and circumstances in which the information is known or used that either party discloses on or after the Effective Date, to the other party or its parents, affiliates' employees, contractors, officers, directors, partners, agents, attorneys, accountants or advisors. Confidential Information includes: business processes, practices, methods, policies, plans, operations, services, strategies, techniques, agreements, contracts, terms of agreements, transactions, potential transactions, negotiations, pending negotiations, know-how, trade secrets, computer programs, computer software, applications, operating systems, software design, web design, databases, records, financial information, results, accounting information, accounting records, legal information, pricing information, credit information, payroll information, staffing information, internal controls, security procedures, sales information, revenue, costs, communications, original works of authorship, customer information, and customer lists. Confidential Information does not include information that: (a) was in the public domain prior or subsequent

to the time such portion was communicated to the receiving party, through no fault of that party; (b) was rightfully in the receiving party's possession free of any obligation of confidence at or subsequent to the time such portion was communicated by the disclosing party; (c) was developed by the receiving party independently of and without reference to any information communicated by the disclosing party; (d) was communicated by the disclosing party to an unaffiliated third party free of any obligation of confidence; or (e) is approved by the disclosing party for release by the receiving party.

INVOICES; PAYMENTS; PAST-DUE INVOICES Unless expressly agreed otherwise, the Fee for the Initial Term will be invoiced on the Effective Date. At least 45 days prior to the expiration of the Initial or Renewal Term, Customer will be invoiced for the Fee for the Renewal Term. Customer will pay all invoices within 30 days of issuance. Unless expressly agreed otherwise, all prices are in United States Dollars. There is no charge for updates to, or new releases of, Included Services. However Siteimprove may launch new modules/services/products that are not covered by the Fee. In the event that an invoice becomes past-due, Siteimprove will notify Customer by phone or email. After Siteimprove has provided notice. Customer will have five business days to pay the past-due invoice. If Customer fails to make the payment by the end of the cure period, then Siteimprove reserves the right to: (i) begin charging Customer interest for the past-due amount at an interest rate of 1.5% per month, or the highest rate allowed by applicable law, whichever is smaller; (ii) discontinue the Included Services; or (iii) terminate this Agreement pursuant to Section 3 (a) (Termination).

#### 3. TERMINATION

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express access grant in this Section 4 is outside the scope of this Agreement.

- d. Support. Siteimprove will provide support to the Customer pursuant to the agreed support plan attached as Exhibit C. In no event will Siteimprove be obligated to furnish support for any version of the Included Services that Customer has modified or altered in any way.
- e. Operational Data. The Included Services are designed to collect certain operational data, which may be used by Siteimprove for various business purposes, which may include customer support, verifying the need for and providing updates to the Included Services, market research and product planning, verifying Customer's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement and protecting Siteimprove's intellectual property. No party will be liable or responsible to the other party, or be deemed to have defaulted under or breached this Agreement, for any failure or delay in fulfilling or performing any term of this Agreement (except for any obligations to make payments to the other party), when and to the extent such failure or delay is caused by or results from acts beyond the impacted party's ("Impacted Party") reasonable control ("Force Majeure Events"). Force Majeure Events include: (a) acts of God; (b) flood, fire, earthquake or explosion; (c) war, invasion, hostilities (whether war is declared or not), terrorist threats or acts, riot or other civil unrest; (d) government order

A change in economic circumstances is not a Force Majeure Event. If a Force Majeure Event occurs, the Impacted Party will provide prompt notice to the other party, stating the period of time the failure or delay is estimated to last. In the event that the Impacted Party's failure or delay remains uncured for a period of 30 days following written notice, either party may terminate this Agreement upon five days' written notice.

#### 7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- a. In no event will either party or its agents, officers, directors, employees, successors, assigns, or Affiliates be liable to the other party or its agents, officers, directors, employees, successors, assigns, or Affiliates for any indirect, incidental, consequential, punitive, or other special damages. This limitation includes any loss of profits, business interruption, goodwill, loss of data/content or the restoration of any of those items.
- b. #### 15. COUNTERPARTS

The Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts. Each counterpart is an original and, when combined with another counterpart, will be treated as part of the same document. Any counterparts of this Agreement may be delivered electronically in PDF format; these formats have the same effect as an original executed counterpart.

#### SEVERABILITY

Any provision of this Agreement that is prohibited or unenforceable in any jurisdiction is ineffective to the extent of that prohibition or unenforceability in that jurisdiction. The validity, enforceability, or legality of the remaining provisions will not be affected.

#### 17. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes and expresses the entire agreement and understanding between the parties. This Agreement supersedes any prior communications, understanding, commitments, or agreements, oral or written, with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement. The parties are not relying on any representations or warranties other than those expressly listed in this Agreement. Any standard or boilerplate terms and conditions included on any document provided by one party to another (e.g., click-wrap agreements and purchase orders)

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are not part of this Agreement and will not be binding on either party. Any changes or modifications to this Agreement must be in writing, acknowledge the intent to amend the terms and conditions of this Agreement and be signed by an authorized representative of both parties before taking effect.

#### 5. SYSTEM AVAILABILITY.
