Districting Process

Step	Description
Two Initial Hearings May 10 & June 14	Held prior to release of draft maps. Education and to solicit input on the composition of districts.
Release draft maps No later than July 5*	Maps must be posted at least 7 days prior to 3 rd hearing.
Two hearings on draft maps July 12 & August 9	Two meetings to discuss and revise the draft maps and to discuss the election sequence.
Map adoption September 13	Map adopted via resolution. Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption.

□ Federal Voting Rights Act	□ Compact
□ No Racial Gerrymandering	□ Contiguous
	Visible (Natural & man-made)boundaries
	Respect voters' choices / continuity in office
	□ Planned future growth





Draft Maps


□ Starting point maps – many changes can be made prior to final adoption


- □ Drawn to illustrate a range of options
