The West Kern Community College District Governing Board is pleased to announce the selection of four finalists for the position of Superintendent/President at Taft College. Following a comprehensive nationwide search, the finalists were recommended to the Governing Board by a representative search committee comprised of faculty, staff, students, and community members.

The finalists, listed in alphabetical order, are **Dr. Samasoni (Sam) Aunai, Clint Cowden, Dr. Jerry Fliger, and Mike Giacomini**. Biographical information for each candidate is provided below.

The campus community and members of the public are invited to participate in the selection process by attending the Candidate Forums and providing feedback. The forums will be held on March 23, 2026. Specific times and locations for each candidate's session are listed below. Faculty, staff, students, and community members are encouraged to attend to hear directly from the candidates. The forums will also be livestreamed and recorded for later viewing.

The Governing Board will conduct final interviews with the candidates on March 23, 2026. A selection is anticipated shortly thereafter, followed by Governing Board consideration and approval of an employment agreement. The anticipated start date for the new Superintendent/President will be determined at a later time.
