

# **Spotlight**



Taft College launched its fully online Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene Administration (BSDH) program in Fall 2024, making it one of the few California Community Colleges to offer a bachelor's degree. This 100% online degree completion program is designed for licensed dental hygienists who have already earned an associate degree and want to advance their education, leadership potential, and career opportunities.

The first cohort enrolled 25 students from across California, representing a diverse group of professionals working in private practice, public health, and education. Enrollment for the Fall 2025 cohort is expected to be similar. The online format allows students to balance coursework with their personal and professional responsibilities, while still engaging in meaningful, academically rigorous learning experiences.

Coursework emphasizes areas that expand the traditional scope of dental hygiene, including leadership, teaching, community oral health, research, and public health systems. Through project-based assignments, students evaluate local oral health needs, design services to address those needs, and develop strategies for patient care administration and education. Students also create individualized professional development plans and gain experience interpreting research to guide evidence-based decisions in a variety of settings. Program learning outcomes are designed to foster critical thinking, lifelong learning, ethical decisionmaking, and a strong understanding of the legal and professional responsibilities of the field. Graduates will be well-prepared to pursue expanded roles in education, public health, research, and advocacy or continue on to graduate-level study.

With its flexible format, expert faculty, and focus on real-world application, Taft College's BSDH program is creating new pathways for dental hygienists to grow as professionals and serve their communities in broader, more impactful ways.
